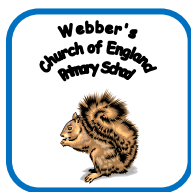

Dear Critical Workers and Parents/Carers of Vulnerable Children,

I am writing to you to confirm arrangements for the subsequent weeks of lockdown and the provision for your child/ren in The Valley Partnership. During this period, we have a significant number of families requiring school provision and have therefore decided to keep both schools open. Your child has been allocated a place at their school, with days as per our discussions.

Please note the following:

**1. Changes to the arrival and collection routine**

- **Webber's Families you will be met as usual:**
  - All EYFS & KS1 children please wait on the stars outside the main front doors (the arch door will not be in use).
  - All KS2 children please wait on the stars in the bottom playground as normal.
- **Burlescombe Families, you will be met as usual:**
  - Please wait on your usual stars in the playground as normal

**PLEASE NOTE: ALL ADULTS MUST** be 2m apart, and one adult per family dropping off and collecting. Adults **MUST** wear masks on school grounds.

## 2. Bubbles and the school day

- There are 3 Bubbles at Webber's and 2 Bubbles at Burlescombe.
- Your child has been allocated an appropriate Bubble.
- Bubble sizes will return to similar sizes as before with 1 child per desk.
- Children in school will follow the same programme of work as home learning.
- Children will have their own class teacher for some of the time, but we endeavour always to have a familiar face in the classroom.
- A hot school meal will be available, and Mrs Cosh is continuing to follow the normal menu (a copy can be downloaded from your school website).

## 3. What to send in

- Children do not need to wear uniform but please wear warm, sensible clothes and shoes.
- Please send in appropriate PE footwear (trainers) AND tracksuit bottoms (in case the weather is damp) - children will have PE but will not need to change completely.
- Please send in water bottles and a very warm/waterproof coat.
- Hat and gloves would also be good during this very cold weather.
- Reading books can come in and out as normal but will be subject to the quarantine box!
- Please do not bring in anything else besides a packed lunch if you are choosing this option.

Unless you have arranged otherwise, and it has been agreed, we are expecting your child every day. Those children not in school full time will be expected to follow the home learning every day they are not in school, unless they are ill.

## 4. When not to send your child in

- If you or your child have signs/symptoms of COVID-19.
- If you have an NHS track and trace telling you/your child to self-isolate.
- If you get COVID - please get your child tested as children often do not have symptoms. We need to protect our staff and other families.
- If you/or child has been in contact with someone with COVID in the last 14 days.
- Your child is generally unwell for the usual reasons.

We really appreciate your vigilance and support on these points above. Please do let us know if you have any questions and please do keep safe and well.
